A year of action @ PT

Picton Terminals has been busy across the region all year. Recently, we welcomed new tugboat Sheri Lynn S to Picton. The new vessel will act as an assist tug for larger vessels coming to the port and will provide other services which we currently contract out. She is captained by a local crew and we are excited by the new directions PT can explore with our new vessel.

PT is proud to supply municipalities from Algonquin Park to Gananoque with road salt to help keep Ontarians safe this winter. Shipping 120k MT of salt

keeps 1,200,000 km of trucking off Ontario's hwy's.

PT spent spring and autumn 2017 shipping recycled surplus limestone from the PT redevelopment construction to Amherst Island for the wind project. We shipped 350k MT of recycled surplus limestone for new road construction on the island.

Additionally, PT supplies surplus limestone and equipment to Rankin

PT is working all winter, when the St. Lawrence Seaway is closed, to ship surplus limestone for the redevelopment of Toronto Harbour and the runway expansion at Kingston Airport.
